All county Blitz rules

- Teams shall be 7 a side
- 3 subs can be used but schools must adhere to a strict panel of ten.
- One hop one solo or two solos rule shall apply
- A goal is three points and one point for an over
- Player fouled or closest to ball shall take free kick or sideline ball.
- Boys may only play in boy's competition. Same rule applies for girls in girl's competition.
- Home team named in blitz shall appoint capable referee/s and ensure readiness of pitch. (ex: sideline marked out, goals with proper goal width Min: 12 x 6 Max: 15x7 etc)
- Home team shall ensure adequate facilities for visiting teams are available.
- If two teams have won an equal number of games in a blitz, the result of their match (during the blitz) will determine the winning team of the blitz.
- If that match was a draw then the score difference rule shall apply.
- All participants must wear mouthguards.

Rialacha Peil na mBuachaillí

(for all league matches excluding blitzes)

1. All games shall be played on pitches of juvenile dimensions with juvenile posts.
(Min: 12 x 6 Max: 15 x7)
2. All league matches (except for blitzes) shall have three periods and the score shall be recorded at the end of the second period, thus ensuring all players get an opportunity to take part.
3. All kick outs shall be taken from the hand from
goaline.
4. There shall be no penalties and the square ball rule shall not apply.
5. 45's shall be taken from the hand 35 mtrs from the end line.
6. Only one hop/one solo or two solos is/are allowed in any one movement.
7. The home team is obliged to appoint a capable referee and ensure readiness of pitch, in particular appropriate goals.
8. All games must be played on the appointed date or with the agreement of both schools during that week.
9. A panel of players (according to league info) and six subs should be chosen.
10. A maximum of three girls shall play on boys teams, only in competitions where specified, and they must execute the pickup properly.
11. Please refer to competition page in booklet for team size and match duration.
12. In the event that two teams finish on equal points, league standings shall be determined by head-to-head results.
13. **All participants must wear mouthguards.**

Rialacha Peil na gCailíní

As above with inclusion of:

1. Players may pick the ball directly off the ground provided that player is in an upright position.
2. All deliberate physical contact is forbidden.
3. A player may not kick the ball as another player is about to pick it up or take it into her possession.
4. **All participants must wear mouthguards.**
5. All other rules for girl's football shall apply.
