and Ardee St.Marys.

I would also like to welcome those lucky supporters who
have managed to get their hands on a ticket and for the first
time ever all those watching on our streaming service LuTV,
who have subscribed from near and far to watch the biggest
games in adult football in County Louth.

This year has been a year like no other in recent memory. We
acknowledge greatly the hardship and sacrifice everyone
has had to endure since the outbreak of the pandemic in
early March. The GAA has stood strong throughout all this,
providing help and support for all and really showing that
community is at the heart of everything the GAA is about.

Back in March, we did not think that we would reach this
weekend. The CCC had the arduous task of planning
fixtures, not knowing if their efforts were to be futile or
whether a single ball would be kicked or pucked at all
this season. Thankfully down to the efforts of every single
person we managed to get society open again and in turn
we managed to get our games back on, but in a much more
condensed manner than we have ever seen before. Games
started mid August and one month later we have reached
the final of each grade. Huge credit goes to the CCC, to
the clubs, the match officials and county board officers for
ensuring that all games have ran so smoothly that we have
reached our showpiece games.

In the Junior Championship we have near neighbours
Lannleire and Naomh Fionnbarra challenging for the
Christy Bellew Cup. For many years these clubs have played
together at underage level so therefore there will definitely
be sense of familiarity and friendship among the players.
Saying that the rivalry between both clubs is huge and it
should be a great battle between the two most impressive
teams in the grade all season.

In the Intermediate Championship we see St.Brides looking
to win their first championship title in 53 years. The also face
near neighbours Kilkerley Emmets, who themselves will be
looking to put last years disappointment behind them, having
lost out to Mattock Rangers at the same stage last year.

In the minor final we have the novel pairing of St.Kevins/
St.Michaels v Cooley Kickhams/Cuchulainn Gaels hoping
to win the Fr Murray Cup. Since 2014 only 3 clubs have
managed to get their hands on the trophy with Ardee
St.Marys, Newtown Blues and Naomh Mairtin each winning
it twice. As this is the last year of Minor football in the U18
age group their will be a sense of great pride in being the last
team to win at this age.

Our final game of the weekend will see Naomh Mairtin play
Ardee St.Marys in the Senior Championship Final. Both
teams have had great success in recent years at underage
level and will hope to carry this success into the senior ranks.
Ardee St.Marys will be hoping to get their hands on the Joe
Ward trophy for the first time since 1995 and Naomh Mairtin
will be looking to win it for the first time in their history having
gone agonisingly close in the last two years.

Special word of mention to the Newtown Blues on
their fantastic achievement in winning three senior
championships in a row. They didn't relinquish the trophy
without a fight last weekend in what was definitely one of
the games of the season so far. Lets hope this weekends
games can match the excitement, skill and passion shown
in all semi finals that were played last week.

Sadly over the past few months our clubs and county have
lost members, friends and Louth Gaels. We would like to
